

Regulation

The conduction of Ukrainian national school and the International chess tournament «Open Puscha Voditsa»

1. Purpose and objectives

Ukrainian national school and the international tournament «Open Puscha Voditsa» (competition is next) is conducted with the purpose:

- the attraction of the population to the occupations to physical culture and sport;
- the development and popularization of chess direction in state;
- the sportsmen skill raising;
- the opportunity to take a part in the high level international tournament.

2. The date and place of the competition

The competitions have held from October the 28th till November the 4th 2017, Yunkerova st., 76 b., Pushcha-Voditsa, Kiev, UKRAINE in the room of Children's establishment of the improvement and rest «Pushcha-Vodytsa» of the Ukrainian trade Union of workers of education and science.

3. The competitions organization and management

The competition is held with the assistance of the Ukrainian Ministry of youth and sports, Ministry of education and science, chess Federation and the Ukrainian trade Union of education and science.

The tournament organizers are: the Department of the education and science, youth and sport (Kyiv city state administration), the Centre of children and youth creativity "Shevchenkivets" and the public organization "Chess center".

The responsibility for the places preparation and competitions are direct by Public organization "Chess center" and the judge collegium, which is approve by the chess Federation of Ukraine.

4. Participants

Sportsmen from the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, all the regions of Ukraine, Kiev and Sevastopol are allowed to the competitions.

The attire of participants must comply requirements to the dress code of the European chess Union.

The competition is held according to the Swiss system with 9 rounds.

Time control – 90 minutes + 30 seconds for every move, starting from the first one.

Allowed time of the delay is 60 minutes.

The definition of participants pairs of the next round is after ending all the batches of the previous round is accordance to the computer program – Swiss Manager FIDE according to FIDE ratings.

5. Description of the event

Tournaments are held according to the Rules of chess sport competitions. The competition is personal. The results of the tournaments will be calculated by national and international rankings.

Tournaments are held according to the "Rules of chess FIDE" and "Tournament rules of FIDE", which are relevant since July the 1st 2017.

7. Safe and preparation of the competition

The places of competitions is carried out according to the decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine till December the 18th 1998 named № 2025 "about the preparation of sport buildings and other specially allotted places for preparation of mass sports and cultural events".

8. Rules of the championship and awarding the winners

Places of participants are determined by most amount of points.

In case, two or more players have equal points the preference provided:

If the coefficient Buchholz is full;

If a reduced coefficient Buchholz 1 (without one worse result);

If a reduced coefficient Buchholz 2 (without two worst results);

By number of victories;

By the results of a personal meeting, if they played to each other;

By the results of additional matches "Armageddon" from two parties, with the time control;

3 minutes with 2 seconds added to every participant before the end of the game (only to determine winners).

To calculate the coefficients of Buchholz games that have not been played or in which both of the participants didn't make any move - is considered as they played with the "virtual opponent".

The winners award is according to the Appendix №1 of this Regulation.

9. The terms of financing activities and participants support

The costs of organizing and carrying out of competitions are carried out by the extra budgetary funds raised by the organizers.

Participation costs are paid by sending organizations.

10. The terms and the submission procedure of participation in the competition

The winners of both tournaments will be award with diplomas and medals.

1. Passage

The way you can go the Children's institutions of rehabilitation and recreation "Pushcha Voditsa" is #17 tram (from the "Obolon" underground station) and #12 tram (from the "Kontraktova square" underground station), the final station is "13 line" also you can use both of it from "Taras Shevchenko" square.

Anyway, it is possible to use bus (#719, #226 from the "Nivki" underground station and #30 from the "Akademgorodok" underground station, the final station is "13 line".

2. Accommodation

Accommodation of participants is planned in the rooms of four-story residential buildings (two/three persons/room) all the private facilities are in, including triple meals, on the one week term, the price is 3700 UAH/person.

Accommodation of participants in the rooms of four-story residential buildings with partial conveniences (sink is at the room, shower and toilet are at the floor), (three/four persons/room), including triple meal, on one the week term, the price is 2900 UAH/person.

For participants from Kyiv and Kyiv region it is possible to stay without accommodation but with every day lunch, on the one week term, the price is 1200 UAH/person.

Also, there is an café on territory.

The costs on passage, meals and accommodation for participants from other cities are on organizations that them sends (accommodation – 100 UAH/day, meals – 154 UAH/day).The pay on the spot is available.
